# STEP 1

## **Springboard Session**

Saturday 28th & Sunday 29th March (beginning of Victorian Term 1 Holidays) Venue: 73 Grattan St., Carlton. Green Monday Studios

Among other things we will look at the Yoga connection. Especially considering the elemental movement model of earth, air, fire water and space as they pertain to movement of the body, emotions and spirit and their relationship to human creativity encompassing all ages.

Appropriate music, props and space arrangements to enhance the dance experience feature in every session.



### **Doorways to Creativity**
